Why Burning Man?

Black Rock City operates as a gift economy, but logistics — water, fuel, art support — still need value exchange. Current methods (cash, donations, outside sponsorships) don't capture the immediacy of abundance within the Playa.

Art Grants

Instant Solar funding to artists building large installations.

Digital artifacts honoring community contributions, Solar-backed.

Water & Fuel Nodes

Transparent, tax-inclusive settlement for essential supplies.

Playa Power Grid

On-site PPA-style redemption for Solar → kWh equivalence.
